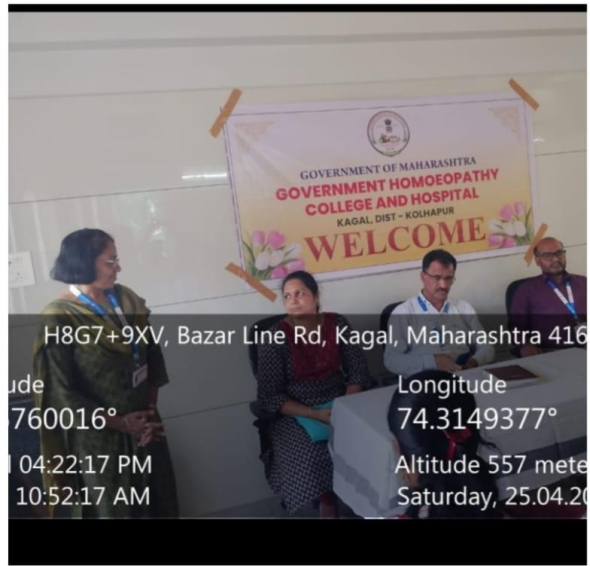




THE OBSERVANCE OF WORLD MALARIA DAY- 2026
